Zlín – The second day of the Zlín Film Festival will fully live up to the theme of Explore & Discover. There are several gatherings based on travel in the program. Steve Lichtag is taking audiences into the wild nature of the island of Aldabra, Dominik Bari will show us life in Oymyakon, the coldest village in the world, and Frank Thomas Grapl is bringing a Maori cultural group to showcase the popular Haka warrior dance. Day with Škoda Car is taking care of the all-day entertainment on Náměstí Míru Square, and in the evening the band Mirai will be playing in the Concert Zone.

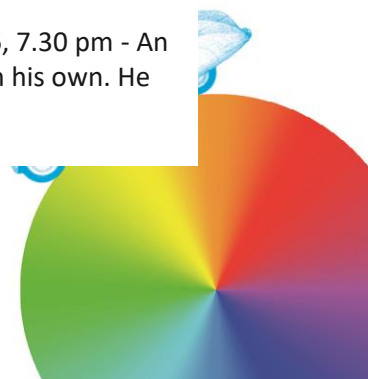
